Who are we?

Impact Journey was established in 2015 and has been an online platform that focuses on unique, impactful and visual journeys, highlighting complex issues within the North-South relation. Previous- and ongoing journeys have focused on inequality, exploitation, climate change and the (incomplete and incorrect) representation of 'the other'. The aim is - besides creating awareness - to focus on actual action and change (behavioral change, time investments, signing petitions, lobbying, advocacy, etc.)

The platform was officially launched past July, with an exhibition and event in Pakhuis de Zwijger, Amsterdam.
